## FAIR PLAY/RESPECT PATCH APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Please follow these instructions carefully!! EYSA is not responsible for any damage that may occur to player's uniforms during application of these patches.

## **Application Location**

Patch is to be applied centered on the front left leg of player's shorts, 2-2% inches above the hem line, as shown in the following photos.



## **Heat Application Instructions**

- 1. Pre-heat a dry iron to the setting for polyester/rayon; typically "3" for most irons.
- 2. Place shorts on a firm surface suitable for ironing. Lay the shorts flat, smoothing the fabric ensuring there are no wrinkles near the application location.
- 3. Position the patch as shown above.
- 4. Cover the application area with a clean sheet of printer paper. This will help to prevent press marks/scorching/damage to the fabric.
- 5. Apply iron to the application location for 20 seconds. Hold iron in place by applying firm, even pressure. Do not twist.
- 6. Remove iron and allow to cool for one (1) minute. Then remove the paper and check for proper adhesion. Check along edges and corners to ensure patch does not start to peel.
- 7. If necessary, re-apply heat in 5 second intervals until patch is properly applied. Try to avoid using a higher heat setting as this may damage the fabric.
